

Clinical Trial Enrollment: Biologic Injection for Lumbar Disc Herniation

If you are suffering from a lumbar disc herniation, you may qualify to take part in a research study.

Our goal is to learn more about degenerative disc disease and assess an investigational bone marrow aspirate concentrate injection as a treatment to support disc healing and prevent chronic low back pain.

Are you eligible?

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Diagnosed with lumbar degenerative disc disease & disc herniation
- A candidate for lumbar microdiscectomy surgery

Study requirements

- Post-operative MRIs in NYC at 3 months, 1 year, & 2 years
- Post-operative surveys at 3 months, 6 months, 1 year, & 2 years
- Adherence to the randomized and blinded study design

Participant benefits

- MRIs with NOCISCAN covered by trial
- Recent clinical studies have shown promising improvements in pain and disc hydration for patients treated with cell-based therapies
